HELLO!
I am Dr. Smith.

INTRODUCTIONS

- Introduce yourself & orient your learner to the learning environment (clinicians, staff, workflow, facilities)
- Elicit information about your learner; ask about prior experiences in this clinical setting & with this patient population

PRE-CLINICAL ENCOUNTER CONVERSATION

- Agree on expectations for the learning environment
- Set realistic & specific goals for the clinical encounter
- Establish psychological safety; Encourage the learner to be curious & ask questions, when appropriate, during the encounter

CLINICAL ENCOUNTER

- Focus on the learning goal
- Use the skills of “think out loud”
- Ask questions or prompt the learner to ask questions

POST ENCOUNTER WRAP-UP

DEBRIEF

- Debrief encounter & reflect with the learner what they observed & learned
- Address any questions & concerns
- Agree upon next steps for continued learning & clarify follow-up, if expected
